Partnerships

- Partnerships as the main tool of Horizon Europe to meet longer-term challenges in prioritized areas
- Research and innovation initiatives of European Commission, private and/or public sector
- Ministry of Transport together with Ministry of Education, Youth and Sports and other relevant stakeholders coordinates the involvement in partnerships from the transport area
- 3 examples of MoT activities in partnerships:
 - co-funded – Driving Urban Transition
 - co-programmed – Connected, Cooperative and Automated Mobility Partnership
 - Institutionalized – Europe's Rail Joint Undertaking

**Driving Urban
Transitions**

- MoT as advisor to the Technology Agency implementing partnership/calls
- Definition of focus areas in transport – „15 Minutes City“ call topics
- 1st call announced in September (pre-proposals), May 2023 full proposals



- MoT representing Czech Republic in the States Representatives Group
- coordination of Czech involvement and participation in CCAM Association
- active role in the SRG Group as the next meeting will take place in November in Prague
- possible future chairmanship of the SRG Group



- MoT established platform for rail research stakeholders for coordination
- priorities advanced through SRG Group (CZ vice-chair)
- two founding members from CZ (AŽD, ČD), involvement of other stakeholders in calls

Synergies with national programmes

➤ TRANSPORT 2020+ and TRANSPORT 2030 Programmes

➤ Specific destinations reflect Horizon 2020 and Horizon Europe priorities

➤ **TRANSPORT 2020+**

- 2020-2026, 1 950 million CZK
- 4 specific destinations:
 - ✓ Sustainable transport
 - ✓ Safe and resilient transport and infrastructure
 - ✓ Accesible and interoperable transport
 - ✓ Automation, digitalisation and navigation and satellite systems

➤ **TRANSPORT 2030**

- **2023-2030, 1 950 million CZK**
- 3 specific destinations:
 - ✓ Sustainable, accessible and safe transport
 - ✓ Automation, digitalisation and technologically advanced transport
 - ✓ Low-emission and green transport

HE Project „FAME“

- Ministry of Transport involved as a partner in Horizon Europe RIA project „FAME“
 - Framework for coordination of Automated Mobility in Europe
- 2021 Call „HORIZON-CL5-2021-D6-01-06: Framework for better coordination of large-scale demonstration pilots in Europe and EU-wide knowledge base“
- 22 partners from 12 countries
- MoT involved in work packages with focus on strategies, projects and initiatives knowledge base and ethical principles of testing of CCAM
