




Traditional crop

- 18-19 centuries the golden era of growers


















Hemp value chain

Actual need of hemp materials in CZ

- 2000 t fiber for insulations
- 4500 t fibers for paper industry
- 200 t shives for building
- 75 t shives for bedding
- 200 t seeds for feed
- 100 t seeds for food
- 50 t oil for cosmetics

10x more than actual supply. Solution: 5000 ha grown hemp national

200 tun flowers for extraction



CzecHemp - intro

- Established 2018
- The main idea: To strengthen the cooperation and know-how of the Czech cannabis and medical cannabis industry.
- The goal: to improve the production and processing chain and bring new technologies for the bioeconomy that will lead to the widespread use of hemp as a natural resource."

Hemp growing

- More than 100 registered varieties in the EU for fiber and seed production
- Act 167/1998 reporting obligation over 100m2
- Limit on THC content in the Czech Republic up to 1%, EU up to 0.3%
- Medicinal cannabis MZČR license


Hemp supports

Hemp paper

- More durable (doesn't turn yellow, doesn't crack) and can be recycled multiple times.
- Solving deforestation.
- Lower consumption of chemicals during production
- Hemp stems grow in 4 months, while trees take 20-80 years.
