

## Instructions for Presentations

### Please read this section carefully!

The presentations will be selected by the co-chairs of each session and therefore it is essential that they are submitted before the deadline, **30 March 2025**.

*Presentations received after this deadline will not be taken into consideration.*

*Also we only accept presentations for review from registered participants. Please register before sending in a presentation.*

You may receive instructions on how to optimize your pitch during the review process - please follow them promptly, as only final presentations can be accepted.

You will receive an email not later than **18 April 2025**, confirming that you have been selected to present your submitted final pitch presentation.

### For presentation of a proposal for a specific topic in the work programme:

As indicated in the template, all presentations should give a short summary of contributions or ideas for a new project proposal. Please carefully select your contribution(s) bearing in mind the limited time of **4 minutes** available for your presentation. Presenting potential consortia must be open for entry from other participants. Priority will be given to presentations by potential coordinators.

### Instructions for project idea pitches:

- The presentation should be submitted using the SMI2G template (download the template [here](#)), and should not be longer than 3-4 slides.
- You will have maximum 4 minutes to present the proposal.
- **Name your file in reference for the topic which the presentation refers to, followed by the name of the participant who will present it (e.g. CL3-FCT-01-04\_YOURNAME).**
  - **NB:** not following this instruction may cause a delay in reviewing your presentation.
- We recommend you present the status of your consortium and what capabilities (or type of partners) you seek.
- You should **not** give a company description or address multiple topics in one presentation. If you want to submit presentations for multiple topics, you must submit a presentation for each single topic.

### Instructions for generic practitioner pitches:

- Practitioner organisations may have a broader interest in a particular destination, covering multiple topics within one single destination. **Only for end-user organisations**

we offer the possibility to have a more generic pitch presentation covering the interests they have in a specific destination.

- The presentation should be submitted on using the SMI2G template for practitioner organisations (download the template [here](#)), and should not be longer than 3-4 slides
- You will have maximum 4 minutes to present your interests.
- **Name your file in reference for the destination which the presentation refers to, followed by the name of the participant who will present it (e.g. CL3-DRS\_YOURNAME).**
  - **NB:** not following this instruction may cause a delay in reviewing your presentation.
- **Send the ppt file to [pres@smi2g.eu](mailto:pres@smi2g.eu).**

A list of the sequence of the presentations for each session will be distributed to the presenters before the meeting.

All presentations will be publicly available for downloading at the CMINE platform after the SMI2G event.
